- Tuesday is the first return day for students on the Temporary Transition Plan- Please be reminded that you can only send your child(ren) back if you have contacted the teacher and school office with at least one week's notice.
- We have had to send home a few uniform infractions this week as some students are still wearing the old Unimax sweaters and pants that are not Top Marks. Please be reminded that students must be in Top Marks uniform items only. Uniform pieces from the previous supplier were phased out September, 2016. Although there has been a big improvement in students' compliance with uniform policy, there is still room for improvement. - **ABSENTEES:** The ministry requires an absentee form for every day that a child is sick.
