CCS will be participating in the CISVA Readers Are Leaders (RAL) competition, a team-based trivia challenge which involves reading and answering questions about award-winning Canadian novels. This program was started by CISVA librarians as a way to encourage students to read the most currently published Canadian children's novels that are nominated by the Red Cedar Books Awards which is British Columbia's *Young Reader's Choice* book award.

Your child has expressed an interest in participating in the RAL competition. They will be part of a team of 6-7 students from their cohort who will each read one (or more) of the selected novels. I will meet with the teams every few weeks during school hours to check in on their progress and ensure that they are reading their books. There will be a competition in late March between all the CCS teams, where they will be challenged to answer questions based on information from the books. There will be one copy of each book provided to the team, however the students are welcome to obtain copies of the books from the public library, or they can order personal copies with the attached order form. Please note that it is not necessary for them to purchase the books, however if they would like to buy their own copy, I can facilitate that.
